1 Collection and use of personal data

When applying for Academy in Exile fellowships, the voluntarily submitted data (name, contact details) including attachments (cover letter, photo, CV, certificates, other supporting documents) will be processed by the Academy in Exile exclusively for the purpose of selecting applicants. The submitted data is only accessible to employees of the Academy in Exile, members of the Academy in Exile Council and Advisory Board, as well as select external specialists with expertise in Afghanistan. All involved persons are obliged to maintain data secrecy in accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulations and are obliged to comply with specific requirements for the protection of applicants' personal data.

2 Information

In accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulations, you may at any time request information in writing about which personal data has been processed, for what purpose, and on what legal basis the data has been processed. You may also inquire in writing about the origin of the data and the recipient, and the general technical conditions of automated processing.

3. Data erasure and retention period

We will delete or block the personal data of a data subject as soon as the specific purpose for retention ceases to exist. Further retention may occur where this is required by European or national lawmakers according to EU regulations, national laws or other provisions applying to the data controller. We will also block or delete the data upon expiry of a legal retention period stipulated in any of the rules referred to above, unless it is still necessary to retain the data for concluding or implementing the terms of a contract.
